Student wellbeing

Wednesday the 8th of May is our next Parent and Carer Coffee morning. This is for all parents and carers across both the Primary and Secondary site. We're also excited to say our Executive Head Teacher, Janette Kennedy will also be attending to meet and introduce herself to parents. We hope to see many of you there!

Apply for free school meals

If you receive any benefits, you should tell your school as they can get extra funding called the Pupil Premium grant. This includes:

- Universal Credit your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum
 Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

Children who get paid these benefits directly can also get free school meals.
